APRIL 1, 2024 MEETING

(May 6, 2024)

A regular meeting of the York Haven Borough Council was called to order April 1, 2024, at 7:00pm. The Pledge of Allegiance and roll call followed. Present were President Bryan Housholder, Vice President Jamie Wolf, Mayor Christine Ebersole, Council members Curtiss Tusing and Robin Issacson, CGA Attorney Evan Gabel, and CS Davidson Engineers Derek Rinaldo and Paul Pope III.

Police Report

Engineers Report

Derek stated, we currently do not have a update on the CDBG application. Hoping to find out more after the next Planning Commision meeting which is scheduled for April 11th. The borough was not awarded funding through the Local Share Grant application for the new equipment purchases. The next window for application is July-Sept.

Solicitors Report

Evan stated, there are no real changes to the refuse report, other than the one property that has filed for bankruptcy. The borough is listed as a creditor so we should receive payment on that property when everything is finalized.

Ordinance Officer

Curtiss stated the car on 2nd street has been removed. Also the ball team complained about the weeds coming from the property to the left of the park entrance. We will need to talk to the homeowner about this.

Citizens

Dan Altimus and colleague from common ground were present to discuss parking lot project. Derek reviewed the county requirement of 8 handicap spaces per 1000sq feet or one for every 25 spaces is what is required. After discussion they requested time to acquire funding for the project. A motion was made by Robin Issacson to grant a 6 month temporary occupancy permit for the parking situation. It was second by Jamie Wolf with no opposition.

Council broke into executive session from 7:30-7:50 to discuss personnel and financial situation. When the meeting resumed at 7:50pm Robin Issacson made a motion to authorize Jamie Wolf to work on updating software, hardware, and getting a credit card for the borough. It was second by Curtiss Tusing and passed with no opposition.

Minutes and Treasures Report

A motion was made by Robin Issacson to accept the meeting minutes and treasures report with the amendment made by Jamie Wolf to include the payment to SWIF. It was second by Curtiss Tusing with no opposition.

Mayors Report

Mayor Christine stated the car on 2nd street had been removed. She plans to pass out flyers to all the residents for the community yard sale on May 4th.

Borough Building

Robin stated NEYCHIP would like to have a grand opening on May 18th and would like permission to use the upstairs for displays free of charge. She would also like the borough to help find and donate items for display, as they are showcasing the Borough for the first 3 months. Jamie Wolf stated she would be fine with NEYCHIP used items from the borough building for display if they provided an itemized list of items used. A motion was made by Robin to allow NEYCHIP to use the upstairs free of charge for the May 18th grand opening. It was second by Curtiss Tusing and passed with no opposition. Curtiss stated we need to have the toilet upstairs serviced before use. A motion was made by Robin to call a plumber to service or replace the upstairs toilet. It was second by Curtiss Tusing and passed with no opposition.

Streets

Nothing at this time.

Playground

Curtiss Tusing said the ball team offered to get mulch for the playground and spread it for the borough.

Unfinished business

Quickbooks has not yet been updated. There is a lot of information that is out of date and needs to be gone through.

New Business

Clean up date is tentatively planned for April, 20th. Still awaiting response from program.
