

YORK HAVEN BOROUGH COUNCIL MINUTES

YORK HAVEN, PENNSYLVANIA

April 7, 2025

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

A regular meeting of the York Haven Borough Council was called to order April 7, 2025 at 7:00PM. Roll call was taken. Present were President Bryan Householder, Council members Curtiss Tusing, Robin Isaacson, Larry Isaacson, Mayor Christine Ebersole, Treasurer, Jennifer Reiner, CGA attorney Evan Gabel and CS Davidson Engineers, Derek Rinaldo and Paul Pope.

Police Report- 46 incidents Warning to keep car doors locked and keep valuables out of sight.

Angie Garrison asked about the rumors of the Newberry police merging with Northern York Regional. Chief Lutz said they had just signed a three year contract so to the best of his knowledge, that wasn't going to happen.

Newberry placed a speed sign on S.Front Street just past Susquehanna. Robin Isaacson noted that it seemed to be effective for slowing down traffic coming into York Haven. They will place one on Landvale coming into town.

Engineers Report- Discussed a number of structures collapsing or in disrepair. CS Davidson will come out to inspect Gay street and 2 Cherry Robin Isaacson moved that CS Davidson inspect the wall at the fire Station and come up with a plan to repair. Curtiss Tusing 2nd. Motion passed.

Borough's 537 Plan Update- As of the sale of York Haven Sewer to York Water, DEP is requiring a 537 Plan Update. The old 537 Plan is from 1986. Derek anticipates this update to cost between \$5-10,000. In the agreement of sale it states that York Water will pay all the costs of transfer. Robin Isaacson moved that Evan contact York Water to pay the costs of updating the 537 Plan as part of their agreement to pay the costs of transfer. Larry Isaacson seconded. The motion passed.

Solicitors Report

Evan stated that when we get to a point where we are not recovering money for the trash bills, to pass those customers on to him and he will begin the legal process. Also those whom we have payment plans with, if they fail to pay, should be turned over as well.

Citizen's

Veronica Grove- handicapped parking- wondered why she needed to reapply every year.

Carlotta Korte- Veronica's handicapped parking space, why do she need to reapply. Larry explained according to ADA we may have too many parking spots for the density of our parking on S Front St. Handicapped residents move or don't need them so we need to keep our spots current. Carlotta got agitated, accused Larry of pounding on the door and talking to Veronica's 15 year old son. Robin Isaacson said she would either need to state her issue respectfully or leave. Carlotta chose to leave.

Brian Korte expressed an interest in returning to the York Haven Borough Council. No parking sign behind 36 S. Front St.

Andela Garrison said she had expressed an interest in being on the York Haven Borough Council, she spoke with Larry, but we hadn't gotten back with her. Robin Isaacson stated she was supposed to set up an interview with Angie and Christine Ebersole and hadn't due to time constraints.

After some discussion we will formally swear them in at the 05/05/2025 meeting.

Minutes 03/03/2025 were read. Robin Isaacson motioned for the minutes to be approved, Curtiss Tusuing 2nd, Motion passed

Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer's report was present with Account balances, revenue and disbursements.

Jennifer Reiner presented three sample letters to send to overdue trash clients. Evan said, one is sufficient. He will send her a sample with proper legal wording.

A motion to approve the minutes and February Treasurers Report and to pay all outstanding bills was made by Robin Isaacson and seconded by Curtiss Tusing. Motion passed.

Mayor's Report

Looked at 31/33 Front. Back yards full of junk. Larry reported 2 ordinances had been mailed, but not able to be delivered. They would go out again according to USPS. If they were undeliverable a second time, they would be returned to the borough.

Also talked about Foam Products on Gay St. being a dangerous structure with the 3rd roof caved in.

Talking with Newberry Township Ordinance officer re: Calhoun Horse and several junk cars on property.

Building

Glass in cracked in message board. Needs to be replaced.

Playground- Curtiss and Matt installed the slide. Still need mulch

Toilet had to be replaced in women's bathroom. Security camera's. All installed have been broken.

Unfinished Business

Pothole repair- Because of the number and depth of the pothole in York Haven, a decision was made to make a count and measure each pothole and send it out for bid. Derrick said we could use liquid fuels money to pay for the costs of repairing the roads.

New Business

Course Vector hopes to have our new website up and running by the end of the month. Need help and pictures for design.
