

York Haven Borough Council Minutes

December 4, 2023

A regular meeting of the York Haven Borough council was called to order November 6, 2023 at 7 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance and roll call followed. Present were Mayor Christine Ebersole, President Bryan Householder, council members Joell Zortman, Tim O'Sheehan, Jamie Wolf and Robin Isaacson. Also present was engineer Derek Rinaldo. Absent from the meeting was Secretary/Treasurer Christine Emig, CGA Attorney Evan Gabel and council members Chad Billet and Mindy Yoder.

Police Report

Engineer's Report

Derek Rinaldo stated the CDBG applications have gone live. He said there is a new grant available which is due January 23, 2023. Council decided to use the CDBG grant money to fix Gay Street. Derek stated he will need a resolution for permission to submit the application. For the new grant council decided to try and obtain a new dump truck for the borough. Derek also stated the land merger for One Common Ground has been approved by York County Planning.

Solicitor's Report

Evan Gabel was absent from the meeting however he left notes for Jamie Wolf to cover. He said the softball field lease is ready and signed. Evan finished the survey for York Water Company. He needed a motion to be in charge and advertise the budget. Robin made a motion to allow Evan to advertise budget and was second by Tim O'Sheehan with no opposition. He suggested for next year's budget to add an extra day to make sure this is completed and advertised.

Ordinance Officer

Curtiss Tusing stated there is a section of Walton Street that Columbia Gas had ripped up for restoration that needs sealed. Derek Rinaldo stated they normally come back around to seal this after they are finished with the jobs in the area. Christine Emig will check with Columbia Gas to see if this is the case. Also, there is a hole forming on Walton and Gay Street. Curtiss will be filling this in soon.

Citizens

Marc Damen was at meeting to obtain completed lease for the ballfield. He also inquired about the bathrooms needing winterized at the ballfield. Council stated they will call someone to have this completed. Sheila Eisele was present to review tax information with council. She stated the residents that did not pay their tax bills were sent another notice. If the bills are not paid by the end of December, they will get turned over to GH Harris for them to collect these fees. Daniel Altimus from One Common Ground brought plans down for land merger. This was approved by York County Planning.

Minutes

Robin Isaacson made a motion to approve the minutes with one correction being made to last month's minutes stating the lease was being prepared for softball field not playground. Joelle Zortman second with no opposition.

Treasurer's Report

Robin Isaacson made a motion to approve the treasurer's report and was second by Joell Zortman with no opposition.

Mayor's Report

Mayor Christine Ebersole stated there is a black ford fusion on 2nd Street that needs to be moved. Also, there are 2 dogs on 2nd Street that are getting out and causing issues. The SPCA will be called to see if they are licensed. The mayor also stated that there was a very good turn out for Trick or Treat.

Borough Building

The borough will be getting new desk and chairs for the office on November 17,2023. These were purchased from Overnight Furniture.

Streets

Curtiss Tusing will be filling in the hole at South Gay and Walton Streets.

Playground

The lease has been completed for the ballfield.

Unfinished Business

Christine Emig is in the middle of changing bank accounts for ACH deposits and then the Fulton Bank account will be closed. The Borough will be purchasing and updating QuickBooks and hooking up new computers in the near future.

New Business

Jamie Wolf will be obtaining quotes from three different places on a new dump truck for the borough. These will be turned over to Derek Rinaldo for submission of the new grant.

Tim O'Sheehan made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:20 and was second by Jamie Wolf.
