

YORK HAVEN BOROUGH COUNCIL MINUTES

October 7, 2024

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

A regular meeting of the York Haven Borough Council was called to order October 7, 2024 at 7:00PM. Roll call was taken. Present were President Bryan Householder, Mayor Christine Ebersole, Council members Curtiss Tusing, Robin Isaacson, Larry Isaacson, CGA attorney Evan Gabel and CS Davidson Engineers, Derek Rinaldo and Paul Pope.

Police Report

There were 50 calls.

Engineers Report

We have applied for a grant through Local Share for a new Bobcat for the borough. Robin moved and Curtiss seconded the motion to sign the contract for the new Bobcat. Motion passed.

Solicitors Report

We have not completed our 2022 and 2023 audits. That will have to be done to receive our grants. Jenn will get in contact with the auditors. Larry moved and Curtiss seconded to have trash contracts for 2025 go out to Republic and Penn Waste for 2 and 3 year contracts, with and without the company's doing the billing. Motion passed.

Citizen's

Charles Stambaugh came to thank the Borough for its support and to get a contract signed for the use of the hall for 10/12/2024 for Jim McClure to speak about the history of Mt. Wolf from 6-7:30.

Mark Sanders, Fire Chief for 1st Susquehanna Fire Department came to request \$10,000.00 from the fire account to pay for repairs to the fire hall. He needs a letter stating why a payment was made late.

He stated that there is a no burn permit within 150 feet of a property line. There are only two houses with that much square footage. We received a request from 1 Cherry Ave. They may not burn building materials.

He presented a problem to the borough happening at 20 2nd Street, York Haven. The property is rented to a single mother with children. Her mother, who weighs at least 450 pounds had come to live with her. The fire company has responded to 20 calls in the past two months when the mother has fallen, or needed to get to the hospital. They need to call in Newberry Fire Company to help because she's too heavy for the manpower at Susquehanna FD to move her without help. They are asking for help either legally or through social services.

Timothy O'Sheehan came to state that the borough should not handle the trash bills.

Minutes

Treasurer's Report

Jennifer Reiner was introduced to the all Borough Council and Evan Gabel, Derek Rinaldo and Paul Pope. She was able to talk about her background and experience at Mt. Wolf Borough. A motion was made by Robin Isaacson and seconded by Curtiss Tusing to appoint Jennifer Reiner as the Treasurer of York Haven Borough. Motion passed.

The Treasurer's report was present with Account balances, revenue and disbursements.

A motion to approve the minutes and the Treasurers Report and to pay all outstanding bills was made by Robin Isaacson and seconded by Curtiss Tusing. Motion passed.

Mayor's Report
